

SECTION 4(Page 2) of St Luke's Healing Foundation Constitution

PURPOSE AND OBJECTS

The principal purpose of the company is to provide direct relief of suffering, distress, misfortune and helplessness to members of the public in Australia in a non-discriminatory way. In pursuit of the principal purpose, the objects of the company are:

- aa) to provide relief, support and healing in order to alleviate human need and suffering in any form, especially in relation to homeless people, drug and alcohol addiction, poverty and victims of domestic violence;**
- ab) to care for those in need of relief, support, and healing holistically by providing food, accommodation, health care, sporting facilities, education and referrals to employment opportunities;**
- a) to provide relief, support and healing to persons who have a terminal, chronic or life-threatening illness and to their families, dependants, relatives carers, friends and others concerned for them;**
- b) to provide relief, support and healing to the bereaved;**
- c) to provide such relief, support and healing in any possible way, including physical, medical, material, financial, pastoral, spiritual, psychological and emotional;**
- d) to provide such relief and support by teaching about the nature of any illness or distress and how to tolerate and overcome it and how to care for, help and support those who are ill;**
- e) to provide such relief support and healing:**
 - (i) through in-home services and in-patient facilities;**
 - (ii) in co-operation with any other persons; and**
 - (iii) at healing centres, sanctuaries, hospices and respite centres provided by the company; and**
- f) to do all such things as are ancillary, incidental and conducive to any of the above objects.**
